 2. Lay down = tithemi (τίθημι), to lay aside, to wear or carry no longer
 - B. He Acted from Trust
 1. John 13:3; Matthew 28:18
 2. Contrast to His Authority
 - a) Luke 19:38-40; Mark 11:13-14, 20; Matthew 21:12-13
- II. Jesus Dips The Bread
 - A. Charoseth
 - B. Slavery
 1. Matthew 26:20-25; Romans 6:16; Romans 3:23
- III. Jesus Breaks The Bread
 - A. Passover Meal
 - B. Matzah Bread
 1. Unleavened - without yeast, represented sin
 - a) Leviticus 2:11; Matthew 16:6
 2. Striped
 - a) 1 Peter 2:24
 3. Punctured
 - a) John 20:27

 - A. Four Cups
 1. Exodus 6:6-7
 - B. Cup of Sanctification (Opened the Passover)
 - a) "I will bring you out from under the Egyptians" - 1 Peter 1:15-16
 - C. Cup of Deliverance (After the Washing)
 - a) "I will rescue you from slavery." - Romans 8:1-2
 - D. Cup of Redemption
 - a) "I will redeem you" - Exodus 12:13; Ephesians 1:7
 - E. Cup of Praise and Restoration
 - a) "I will take you as My people" - 1 Peter 5:10; Matthew 26:30
